MJSC Junior Board: Members will be selected by a process of application by majority vote of the Executive Board and Board of Directors.

Requirements –

1. Must be a current member of the MJSC.
2. Must be a motivated MJSC member from age 14 to 20 years old.
3. Must be able to serve a two year term limit.
4. Cannot be a member of the MJSC Junior Board once they have passed the maximum age of membership.
5. Must apply by application.
6. Must be able to attend meeting as necessary.

Responsibilities – but not limited to

1. Assist with membership growth and retention.
2. Serve as a liaison for the membership (help with communication between the young membership and the senior board).
3. Organizing the membership to help assist show management with ring help, etc.
4. Help with educational and youth activities for the membership.
5. Members will be expected to attend and act as a MJSC representative at NO FEWER than 4 circuit shows.
6. Members are expected to attend any meetings that the Executive Board and/or Board of Directors ask them to attend.
7. Members are expected to uphold an ethical manner at all MJSC events. They serve as a role model and representative for the MJSC and should act as such.
8. Members are expected to help promote MJSC social media accounts such as Facebook.
