

Magnolia Junior Swine Circuit

Mission

To encourage youth of Mississippi to participate in swine shows and educational opportunities, while enhancing show ring skills and knowledge of their 4-H and FFA projects.

General Information

1. The Magnolia Junior Swine Circuit (MJSC) is a 3 weekend series of shows. Each weekend consists of 2 shows, showmanship and a contest. All shows will be run by MJSC show management. There are also 2 independent sanctioned shows by local 4-H Livestock Associations that count as full point shows.

Entry Fees/Prizes for shows will be as follows:

\$20 per head – 70% minimum payback

\$10 for showmanship – 100% payback

Add-On Cash and/or prizes will be awarded to top 5 placings per class, breed champions overall grand and reserve grand pigs per show.

OTHER SANCTIONED EVENTS:

*November 28 Jasper County Holiday Classic, Bay Springs, Mississippi

*December 4-5 – 2 Shows - Sunflower County and Humphreys County

*These shows are independently run. Fees and Prizes may vary.

*Mississippi residents not participating in the MJSC swine circuit are eligible to show in any of the above shows.

The show season will consist of a series of shows with the final awards banquet being held at the finale of the show. Prizes will be awarded to the top 10 in each breed division. Prizes will be given for showmanship division, skill-a-thon, sales talk and overall top 5 pigs. Prizes will be decided based on funding.

All MJSC sanctioned shows are required to have the following:

- Showmanship
- Commercial Gilt Show
- MS Bred Barrow Show
- Market classes for the following breeds – Hampshire, Yorkshire, Chester, Duroc, All Other Crossbred, Dark Crossbred, Spots, AOB, Hereford

Sanctioned shows are responsible for keeping an official record of the show and is to be submitted to MJSC coordinators within 3 days after completion of the show.

Currently there is a \$100.00 fee for a show to become sanctioned.

2. MJSC exhibitors must be between the ages of 4-21. Membership is limited to Mississippi residents.
3. A \$25 fee per family will be assessed to become a member of MJSC. A family unit will consist of siblings and step siblings only. Cousins, nieces and nephews will have to have their own membership. This membership provides each family with one vote/family, if a family would like to add another voting right/child, there will be an additional \$5.00 fee. Adults that would like to join that don't have youth participants can join for the \$25.00 fee.
4. Each pig entered in MJSC will be required to have a MJSC ear-tag. These will cost \$10 per tag.
5. A weigh-back can be conducted at any time during a show.
6. Any grievances must be presented to the MJSC Board of Directors within 12 hours of incident, in writing and accompanied by a \$250 cash non-refundable fee. However, if the Board of Directors and Executive Board approves the grievance, the money will be refunded.
7. Any mistakes found in point system need to be reported in writing to Leanne.
8. Pigs must be entered and shown by the name of the MJSC member who wishes to accumulate the points. If the MJSC member has more than one pig in the same class a substitute showman will be allowed. If for some reason a pig is moved to a different division once the shows have started, those points will be lost.
9. There is no limit to the number of pigs a member can exhibit.
10. Points will be accumulated for members in each of the following breed divisions: MS Bred Barrow, Yorkshire, Hampshire, Spots, Duroc, All Other Crossbred, Dark

Crossbred, AOB, Hereford, Chester and commercial gilts. Points will also be accumulated for showmanship classes. Special contest may also be held during the year, with prizes being based on participation level and funding.

11. Points will be awarded on the following basis to qualified members of the MJSC for the yearly awards in each division. Points are recorded in a class based on the number of pigs that are exhibited in the class. The MJSC will not be responsible for no-shows at the gate.

5*=every animal in class from this place to last place will receive 5 points.

MJSC reserves the right to correct point standings at any time during the year.

Breed Champions will receive 5 bonus points and Reserve Breed Champions will receive 3 bonus points. Additionally, at each sanctioned show, the judge will select a Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, 3rd Overall, 4th Overall, and 5th Overall. You must be either Breed Champion or Reserve Breed Champion to compete for the Overall selections. The following points will be awarded to those selected animals. Grand Champion 5 bonus points, Reserve Grand Champion 4 bonus points, 3rd Overall 3 bonus points, 4th Overall 2 bonus points and 5th Overall 1 bonus point.

12. In the event of a tie in the points standing, the highest average placing in classes over the 6 shows will win the tie.
13. In the event of a first place tie in showmanship, the second judge for the final weekend show will break the tie during a show off. If there is a tie for 2nd-10th the prizes will be evenly divided.
14. There will be a total of 9 sanctioned shows. Only 7 shows will count for the total number of points. Each pig will drop the lowest point shows. If you skip a show that will be your drop score. There will also be a drop score in showmanship, there will be a possible 5 showmanship shows and only 4 will count.
15. Commercial Gilt Show
 - a. There will be a commercial gilt show at each show.
 - b. Commercial Gilts cannot show in regular market show and the commercial gilt show. They can only show in one or the other.
 - c. Gilts will be broken down by breed groups and weight classes.

- d. Points will be awarded in the commercial gilt show just like other breed divisions.
- e. No limit to the number of gilts an exhibitor can enter.

Breed Groups

- Crosses
- Down eared breeds
- Up eared breeds

16. Dark Crosses and All Other Crosses Explanation:

(a) DARK CROSS – To classify as a dark cross, the animal must have black pigment & hair in the same location.

Examples: black belted, white hog black spots, calico with black spots, white hog with a black head are all classified as Dark Cross.

(b) ALL OTHER CROSS- To classify as an all other cross, the animal must have white and non-black pigment.

Examples: Red Belts, Red Roans, Blues & Blue Butts (including blues with black pigment on snout and toes)

2. Premise I.D. is required.
3. All Youth Participants are required to have a current PQA number.
